

**Larksville Borough
Council Meeting
March 3, 2026**

Council Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Lehman with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

Roll Call: Mr. Chase, Ms. Davis, Mr. Hudak, Ms. Stochla, President Lehman, Mayor Zawadski, Solicitor Malak, and Ms. Valatka. Absent were Vice President Austra and Mr. Hooper.

Officer Report

Police Commission-Solicitor Malak stated the WSRPD is up and running. There are 2 different pension plans involved so we need to be aligned. There are issues with the School Resource Officer, and we are working on a new contract.

Solicitor Malak-no formal report.

Fire-Ms. Davis reported a total of 32 responses for the month with 50.5 personnel hours. There were 4 EMS assists, 4 accidents, 10 mutual aid assists and other miscellaneous calls.

Recreation-Ms. Davis said the Easter Egg Hunt will be coming up and she will reach out to State Street School.

Road-Ms. Davis has no formal report. We are getting many calls for potholes, and they will be filled asap.

Engineer-Ms. Valatka stated Quad 3 is waiting for an extension on the multi-modal grant for Nesbitt, Chestnut, Orchard and W 1st St.

Code-Mr. Thomas reported 3 rental inspections, and rental registrations are coming in.

West 1st St. will be paved? Ms. Valatka advised it is on the list to be done.

Mr. Donnelly-W. 1st St.-There are no storm drains on our street. The water just lays there. President Lehman said the engineer is working on this. A swale or storm drain may be installed.
